Member Photos and ID Info

Member ID cards are no longer issued by the RCMP or Rocky SAR. The OFC will be producing the cards. Currently, they are unable to get the information from D4H for the ID Cards. Since the Government of Alberta has specific requirements for photos we will need to do re-takes of all members.

Currently, in D4H under Intelligence>Documents>ID Cards there are two files, please fill out the appropriate form and email to me as soon as possible. If there is more than one member in a household part of Rocky SAR, do not use the same phone number for both individuals. The phone number will be how individuals are identified for replacement cards etc.

Pets

An RCMP request has been brought to our attention. Please do not bring any pets with you on an incident. It is safer for them and team members if they are left at home. We never know how long we will be at a given incident.
